About Us

The Willmar Fire Department is considered a paid-on-call department. Firefighters are paid an hourly rate at 1-hour increments for fire calls and training. Members carry tone/voice pagers that notify them when the department is needed for service.

Our department gets paged for a variety of services:

Battalion

- Vehicle Accidents and Fires: The department is split into two battalion units that alternate responding each month.

Weather Watch

- Willmar firefighters provide severe weather standby and assist the surrounding fire departments and other emergency response agencies in the detection of and warning for severe weather.

Mutual Aid

- Other departments throughout Kandiyohi County may call upon us to assist with incidents in their jurisdiction.
- Generally, these are structure fires or large grass fires.

Special Teams/Services

- Hazardous Materials Emergency Assistance Team (HEAT): Comprised of firefighters and EMT's throughout the county.
 - The HEAT team is specially trained to respond to various chemical spills and responds throughout the county or where needed.
- Technical Rescue Team (TRT): Comprised of Willmar Fire Department, Willmar Ambulance Service and Kandiyohi County Rescue Squad members.
 - The TRT team is specially trained in confined space, rope, trench and high angle rescues and responds throughout the county or where needed.

Full Department

- Full department calls make up the remainder of the alarms. These include anything from the routine false alarms to working grass or structure fires.

Fire Chief

The Willmar Fire Chief / Fire Marshal is a full-time position whose immediate supervisor is the City Administrator. The Chief has a wide array of responsibilities, some of which include:

- Overseeing the day to day operations of the department, full-time staff and firefighters
- Assuming Command during emergency responses
- Coordinating the City's emergency management plan
- Managing the department budget
- Ensuring the department and firefighters are in compliance with NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) and OSHA (Occupational Safety and Health Association) standards
- Conducting fire investigations
- Assisting law enforcement officials and the State Fire Marshal's Office with arson investigations
- Enforcing the International Fire Code within the community and issuing corrective orders
- Assisting with building inspections for new construction and remodels
- Inspecting and testing fire alarm and sprinkler systems within the community
- Addressing fire code questions and concerns of the public
- Determining and analyzing City water flow
- Conducting day/foster care and commercial inspections

Marv Calvin has been Willmar's Fire Chief/Fire Marshal for 8 years. He has worked in the fire and EMS field for over 30 years.

Willmar Fire Department Officers are appointed for 3-year terms by the Officer Selection Committee. The City Administrator provides final approval for each new appointment.

Advanced training and established years of experience are prerequisites for becoming an Officer as they take on additional responsibilities and assume critical roles during emergency responses. Each truck responding to an incident must contain an Officer prior to departure.

Officers also assist the Fire Chief with day-to-day operations, assist with incident command and help to uphold the department's disciplinary procedures.

Firefighter Training

Full-department training is generally conducted the first three Thursdays each month. Firefighters train on a variety of subjects including CPR/First Aid, driving, search & rescue, ventilation and live burns.

During 2007, several department members focused on wildland firefighter training. This 40-hour class was partially funded by a grant through the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service.

Firefighters are also given the opportunity to attend outside training classes. Many of these courses are taken at Minnesota State Fire/EMS/Rescue Schools conducted by community and technical colleges throughout the state. This also allows the firefighters to meet their 12-hour school requirement placed on them every 3 years.



Fire alarms outside Willmar city limits are considered rural alarms. There is a fire protection agreement between the City of Willmar and each of the townships noted below.




2007 False Alarms

Approximately one-third of our calls are false alarms. The fire department allows 5 false alarms at each address per year (July 1 through June 30). Each additional false alarm costs the venue \$250.

Most false alarms are caused by faulty alarm/sprinkler systems or user errors. Those alarms deemed to be malicious are often times further investigated by the Fire Chief and/or the Willmar Police Department.

During 2007, the Willmar Fire Department responded to 116 false alarms, 8 of which were charged for and 4 of which were suspected of being malicious alarms.






